Shelly Norris President At the Calgary Women's Emergency Shelter, the past year has once again been a difficult one, for our agency and for our community. COVID-19 became part of our daily lives and has required all of us to change quickly and often. We have needed to be agile, flexible and adaptable. 2021–2022 brought many challenges, but also many opportunities.

The past year has shown the resilience and dedication of our organization as we managed dramatic increases in the volume, complexity and risk of our work. Our passionate and committed team continued to work diligently to ensure the safety needs of those who rely on our services were met. Our programs and services were offered in person and digitally to accommodate the health needs of our community and our clients. The need for supports and services last year significantly exceeded the need in previous years. Our agency, staff and board mobilized to expand our services and programs to meet the increasing need.

Those impacted by family violence and abuse continued to experience increased fear, uncertainty and stress. programs & services

We play an important role in the daily lives of families and individuals impacted by family violence and abuse in our community. Our counsellors and staff are on the front lines to provide safety and hope through various innovative programs and services.

24-hour family violence helpline

Crisis counselling, information and referrals for anyone needing support with family violence and abuse.

emergency shelter

A 50 bed secure shelter for adults who identify as women, with or without children, who are fleeing family violence and abuse.

child, youth & court family program program

Counselling for children and their parents, when there has been family violence and abuse in the home.

Help with navigation of the court system, for anyone who has experienced family violence and abuse and identifies as a woman.

community services counselling

Short and long-term counselling, support, information and referrals for anyone who has experienced family violence and abuse in Calgary and the surrounding areas.

program for youth

Individual and group counselling for youth who have concerns about their close relationships.

service

healthy relationships men's counselling take a stand — a community capacity building initiative

Individual and group counselling for anyone who is concerned they have been abusive to their loved ones.

An educational program designed to help informal supporters (family, friends, neighbours and colleagues) provide helpful responses to people who are experiencing family violence and abuse.

Turning Points Virtual Event

In April 2021, we held our first Turning Points Virtual Event. Hosted by Dave Kelly, the evening featured a candid conversation with Cathy Jones previously of *This Hour has* 22 *Minutes*, as well as an inspiring discussion about family violence prevention with our CEO Kim Ruse, Calgary Police Chief Mark Neufeld, Lana Wells and frontline staff. Men &

After six years of research and piloting, we launched Men &, the online men's wellness presence and the accompanying men's helpline. This digital resource provides information and support to men at the early stages of their help seeking journey, encouraging them to connect with reliable, positive resources for healthy change.

Take A Stand– In New Languages

To help reduce barriers for seeking help, we partnered with ActionDignity to support families and communities to build awareness and improve access through the Take A Stand Cultural Program initiative. This initiative adopts culturally relevant programming by offering training in the first language. Trained facilitators deliver information sessions to groups and organizations from the Filipino, Arabic, Urdu, Punjabi and Hindi speaking communities.

Pet Friendly Rooms Dedication

In November, we officially dedicated our pet friendly shelter spaces. Pets can often be a significant barrier to women leaving a dangerous and abusive situation. Victims will delay leaving or may consider returning to their partner because they fear for the safety of their pets. Two rooms in the Emergency Shelter are outfitted to allow residents to bring their pets with them while seeking shelter. The rooms were dedicated in the names of Jasmine Lovett and Aliyah Sanderson, a mother and daughter who lost their lives to violence.

treasurer's report

This year, the community and the Calgary Women's Emergency Shelter continued to struggle with the impacts of the pandemic, but we also continued to be bolstered by the generosity of our donors and supporters and have been able to offer increased support to meet increased demand for our services. Overall revenue, excluding Government Emergency funding, was up 3%. This, combined with continued focus on managing costs, resulted in a surplus that we will carry forward into the upcoming year, allowing the agency to offer more services as demand continues to rise.


